ORDINANCE NO. 1880

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE PIEDMONT AVENUE FROM THERE INTERSECTION WITH BROADWAY AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH JACKSON TRACE TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Piedmont Avenue between Broadway Avenue on the South and Jackson Trace Road on the East be closed to all traffic, formulating a safer flow of traffic within the City's jurisdiction.

SECTION 2: Closure of Piedmont Avenue between Broadway Avenue on the South and Jackson Trace Road on the East does not constitute a vacation of the street and the City thereby retains public rights to the street and right of way adjoining.

SECTION 3: The closure of the public street described herein will not deprive other property owners of reasonable ingress to and egress from their property, nor will it adversely affect the interest of the public in any way.

SECTION 4: Blockading of either end of Piedmont Avenue between Broadway Avenue on the South and Jackson Trace Road on the East and appropriate signage shall be completed by the City's Public Works Department employees.

SECTION 5: All sections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
