ORDINANCE NO. 1812

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF TRAFFIC ENTERING THE INTERSECTION OF MOUNTAINVIEW ROAD AND ALABAMA HIGHWAY NUMBER 77; TO PROVIDE FOR AND REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BE PROHIBITED FROM MAKING A RIGHT TURN ONTO ALABAMA HIGHWAY NUMBER 77, SOUTH, FROM MOUNTAINVIEW ROAD; AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any commercial truck, van or bus of any size to make a right turn from Mountainview Road into the southbound lane of Alabama Highway Number 77.

SECTION II: The Chief of Police, or his designee, shall erect or cause to be erected at the intersection of Mountainview Road and Alabama Highway Number 77 appropriate signs indicating that a right turn by a commercial delivery truck of any size is prohibited.

SECTION III: Any person who shall be convicted of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar, nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in that jail wherein persons sentenced to imprisonment by the Municipal Court of the City of Talladega are imprisoned for not less than One Hundred Eighty (180) days, or both at the discretion of the Court trying the case.

SECTION IV: All sections of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
